Ms. Franci: I cannot believe we are already in October!! The students are settling in and doing great! For the second quarter we are starting a new incentive program. If the students earn 10 "Caught Being Good!" coupons for the quarter and maintain a grade of C- or better in all classes they will earn a reward at the end of the quarter. For the second quarter we have planned a movie and popcorn!

As the staff and I discussed our incentive program we talked about detentions. Knowing that our job is to teach and have students learn from their mistakes we made adjustments for detentions. For one detention they must get 5 extra "Caught Being Good!" coupons, for 2 detentions they must get 10 extra "Caught Being Good!" coupons, and for 3 detentions they must get 15 extra "Caught Being Good!" coupons. If they receive more than 3 detentions they lose the privilege of attending the reward at the end of the quarter.


Rallies/Spirit Week: Here are a few photos from our rallies and spirit week for September. Notice the one of our new dolphin mascot "Sushi"!




