Dear 7th graders and families,

We are sending home a recommended student supply list. To be successful at MWCS, we ask that students arrive on the first day of school with these supplies. All students must come to school daily with their own supplies.

Note: Students have to keep all of their supplies with them as they transfer classes. We do not provide school lockers.

- Accordion file to organize papers
- 4 composition notebooks (1 for each core subject)
- Lined paper (400 sheets for the year)
- Highlighters (at least 3 colors)
- Colored pencils
- Flash cards (4 packs for the year)
- Whiteboard and whiteboard pens (four different colors)
- Pencils and pens <u>(will not be provided by the teacher)</u>

In English, your student will be reading:

- The Crossover, by Kwame Alexander
- <u>The Outsiders</u>, by SE Hinton
- <u>The Hunger Games</u>, by Suzanne Collins

- Post-its
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Glue sticks
- In January, students will need a protractor and compass for math class

If you are able to buy your child copies of these novels it is recommended. If not, we have a small class supply of worn novels to use in class.

Note: Students have access to chromebooks at school and during lunch but will often need a tablet or chromebook at home to complete homework assignments. Headphones are also provided, however, students may bring their personal headphones if preferred.
